Due to limited space your entry may be subject to selection and unable to be exhibited.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

All entries are eligible for the Overall First Prize.

Artwork may be photographed without fee and used for promotional purposes.

The 1770 Art Show accepts NO responsibility for loss or damage to any art work.

Entrants are encouraged to arrange their own insurances.

The decision of the judge in awarding prizes is final.

An award may be withheld if in the judge's opinion work submitted is of an unacceptable standard.

The 1770 Art Show reserves the right to reject any work submitted. Artworks will be rejected if not complying with size & weight requirements.

ENTRY PAYMENT DETAILS

A non-refundable ENTRY FEE of \$20 per adult entry and \$5 per student entry.

All entry fees are non-refundable.

ENTRY FORM DUE DATE:

Payment of total ENTRY FEE and COMPLETED ENTRY form must be received by Friday April 28, 2023 by 5 pm.

Entry Form and Monies can be taken to the Bendigo Community Bank in business hours by the due date.

NO late entries will be considered.

REFUND POLICY

In the event that the Art Show is cancelled all entry fees paid will be refunded.

ARTWORK DIMENSIONS

Painting, drawing, photographs, mixed media, textile art maximum 180cm x180cm.

Sculptures must be able to be carried by two people.

ARTWORK DETAILS

All entries must be the unaided work of the entrant alone. All artwork must have been completed within 12 months prior to Saturday April 29, 2023.

Artwork entered cannot have won a prize at any previous art exhibit.

Workshop projects and commercially produced kits are not eligible.

A 20% commission will be retained by the 1770 Art Show on all sales. (Excluding student sections).

Bank Account details must be provided for funds (less commission fees) to be direct deposited. If no bank account details have been provided with the entry form, a cheque will be issued in due course.

No works are to be removed for the duration of the exhibition.

ARTWORK DELIVERY by Mail

We advise entrants to insure their artworks and to use adequate packing materials. Packing materials will be labeled and retained for repacking.

Sufficient stamps/payment must be included for artwork(s) to be returned by post.

ARTWORK INTAKE

Artwork(s) arriving by hand must be delivered to Agnes Water Community Centre, 71 Springs Rd, Agnes Water, between **2pm and 4pm on Saturday, May 13, 2023.**

Artwork(s) arriving after this time will not be accepted.

ARTWORK COLLECTION

Collection of artwork(s) is between **1.30pm to 4pm Sunday, May 21, 2023.** No artwork may be removed before then. If you are unable to collect your artwork, please make prior arrangements. Pickup by agent with written permission and proof of identity is required. The Committee will not pay for any freight to return artworks.

Works NOT collected on Sunday, May 21, 2023 will incur a \$50 handling and storage fee for up to two weeks, after which time the artwork(s) become property of the convenor The 1770 Art Show.

MOTION/ANIMATION

ENTRIES MUST BE INCLUDED WITH ENTRY FORM by Friday April 28, 2023, by 5pm.

Entries will be viewed prior to the 1770Art Show and can be rejected if they are offensive and/or not complying with the Conditions of Entry.

Artists must be the copyright owner of the video/time lapse/short film digital artwork. The digital artwork must have been taken/shot/filmed/ videoed within the last 12 months.

Group entries are accepted with prizes to be shared within the group.

Files must be supplied on USB and include file formats of MP3, MP4 files only. Approximate size up to 5MB and on a loop.

Entries are limited to one video/time lapse/short film or multimedia entry. Duration is maximum 3 minutes/180 seconds including any titles.

Any music must be copyright free, any use of commercial music which is not licensed to the entrant will be disqualified.

HIGH SCHOOL AND PRIMARY SCHOOL

**ONE ENTRY PER STUDENT
ENTRY FEE \$5 per Student entry**

The 1770 Art Show welcomes young artists. This year we have expanded the platform for exhibiting with the following requirements:

Unframed works on paper only, size A4 to A3.

Any medium including paint, pencil, crayon, mixed media and photography.

Categories 1 – 7 (Refer to Entry form for details) – Entry fee \$5

Maximum two entries per category. Follow entry requirements for each category.

Check eligibility for the Local Artist Award and the Emerging Artist Award.

NEW SECTION FOR 2023

MIXED MEDIA

Mixed media art involves combining different creative mediums to create work that incorporates two or more art forms. Materials used to create mixed media art include, but are not limited to, paint, cloth, paper, wood and found objects.

NEW AWARDS FOR 2023

Note: The New Awards Of Local Artist And Emerging Artist Are Not Art Categories. If You Are Eligible For The Local Artist And Emerging Artist Award Please Indicate This On Your Entry Form At No Extra Cost.

LOCAL ARTIST AWARD

Eligible to enter any art section.

Indicate on the ENTRY FORM if you are a permanent resident of the 1770/ Agnes Water region including the following postcodes areas:

EMERGING ARTIST

Eligible to enter any art section.

Indicate on the ENTRY FORM if you are an artist in the process of establishing a professional practice, have exhibited artwork and created a modest independent body of work.

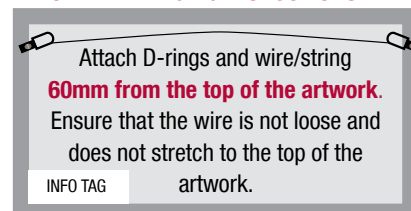
An Emerging Artist may have had artwork accepted into competitions and working to establish an artpractice for five years or more.

An Emerging Artist is not yet formally represented by a major commercial gallery.

An emerging Artist may be self-taught or may have specialist credentials from Visual Art and Design courses like university or college.

These details will be evident in your Artist Biography, 100 -200 words.

IMPORTANT HANGING INSTRUCTIONS



HANGING INSTRUCTIONS

Each artwork must be clearly labeled on the back with an official INFO TAG in lower left corner with the entrant's name, address, phone number, title of artwork, section number, medium & selling price.

Download ARTWORK INFO TAG from our website or tags attached.

Titles and/or prices may not be changed from those listed on the entry form.

Paintings, photographs, textiles and other artwork to be hung for display must be fitted with D-rings and hanging wire, as shown on Important Hanging Instructions above.

Paintings and photographs on stretcher frames will be accepted with all staples at the back and the image continued around all four sides of the canvas.

IF YOUR ARTWORK REQUIRES special hanging instructions, please supply a photograph showing how to hang or stand.

Stretcher frames must also be fitted with D-rings and hanging wire, as per **IMPORTANT HANGING INSTRUCTIONS** above.
